Read Exodus 19:1-6

Questions to think about:

- Who are we and what are we here for?
 - What is the purpose of my life?
 - What story am I part of? What story gives my life meaning?
 - Who are the Israelites and what are they doing in the Bible? What was their purpose? What was their story?
1. Chris talked about the 3 directions God points to in Exodus 19:1-6
 - a. Past grace of God's salvation (vs 4)
 - b. Future grace of God's mission (vs 5)
 - c. Present grace of God's people to live in the world as God's representatives (vs 6)

As you listen to Chris's talk, jot down notes under these three topics.

2. What surprised you in these 6 verses? What words or phrases or ideas jumped out at you? What left you questioning?
3. Chris also talked about obedience. What part does obedience play in making us a holy people?
4. Pick one of the "questions to think about" and answer it for yourself. Share with the group.
