Description:

To provide leadership and planning for a weekly medium size group, pastoral care for leaders and students in that group, and other spiritual formation program support

Responsibilities:

- Plan and lead a weekly medium size group (20-50) focused on one of the following:
 - Bible or book study
 - Topical faith discussions
- Provide teaching (15 minutes/session) and facilitate discussion for the group
- Provide mentoring and leadership development for seminary and undergraduate small group facilitators
- Meet for pastoral care and mentoring with students from medium size group
- Attend 2x/month intern meeting with UMin staff for training, mentoring and program planning
- Attend monthly UMin staff and intern meeting for departmental planning and discussion
- Attend collegelife and/or Chapel
- Recruit and help connect interested students to groups
- Attend beginning of the year UMin Leadership retreat
- Support one or more of the following spiritual formation activities
 - Men's or Women's retreat
 - Small Groups resource coordination

- Strong teaching and communication gifts
- Relational and shepherding skills
- experience in recruiting, gathering, and sustaining a group of 25-50
